

GUIDELINES FOR SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION 2025

(Revised Jan. 11, 2025)

Thank you for your dedication to the performing arts and your interest in the Performing Arts League Scholarship program. The purpose of the Performing Arts League Scholarship program is to encourage individual development and training of student artists in the performance disciplines of Dance, Theater, Instrumental and Vocal Music.

Scholarships are available to students who are current 8th – 11th graders who are active participants in Hamilton County 501(c)3 performing arts organizations. More than one student within the organization may make one scholarship request each. Only one scholarship may be awarded per student per year.

Scholarship applications will be evaluated on the following criteria:

- Evidence that the requested scholarship meets the purpose of the PAL scholarship program as stated above.
- Evidence that the scholarship will aid the student's artistic goals, increase his/her abilities & selected program is compatible with PAL's mission.
- Evidence that teacher recommendation supports student's application & chosen program.
- Evidence that the student has thoughtfully completed application and included all requested information.

Please read and consider funding information below as you complete your application.

The following are examples of activities and expenditures that **ARE** consistent with the funding philosophies of the Performing Arts League:

- Youth arts classes, master classes, and workshops
- Artists-in-residence educational youth outreach programs
- Summer arts camps & intensives
- Private lessons

The following are examples of activities and expenditures that are **NOT** consistent with the funding philosophy of the Performing Arts League:

- Lodging, food, transportation
- Competition fees
- Fundraising activities

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Read all instructions and answer all questions thoroughly.

To complete: copy and paste ONLY Application pages 3-5 into a separate Word document then complete document. Type all information. Be sure to answer all questions and complete all requested information.

Save your Word document as a pdf and submit completed PDF application document as one file to PAL at specified emails. No paper applications will be accepted.

Complete Scholarship Application submission must be emailed by midnight MARCH 7, 2025.

In the interest of fairness and equity, late applications will not be considered.

You should receive an email confirmation of receipt by PAL within 48 hours of submission.

We suggest you request an email read receipt upon submission.

Only complete applications will be considered. All sections and requested information must be included.

Notification of awards will be made by April 30 , 2025.

Download separate Teacher Recommendation Form and send to your current arts teacher.

Contact them prior to sending form and send form in plenty of time for them to submit by deadline. Your application is not complete until Teacher Recommendation Form has been received by PAL.

Students: it is your responsibility to confirm that your teacher recommendation has been sent to PAL.

LEGAL ASSURANCE & PARENTAL PERMISSION TO APPLY: *(In the event that a scholarship is awarded as a result of this Application, the recipient agrees to the following terms and conditions as signified by the applicants' signatures. This Application shall become part of the legally binding contract between the applicant and the Performing Arts League.)*

- **Should you decide that your student will not attend the program for which you are requesting assistance after application has been submitted, PAL must be notified immediately. Failure to do so may result in ineligibility for future scholarships.**
- The scholarship award must be used only for the requested need. The award will be paid directly to the performing arts organization, camp, workshop that student will attend, or named teacher with whom student will study.
- **No funds will be awarded or check mailed to program/teacher until parent/guardian has confirmed student attendance by replying to award email within FIVE days of notification. Parent and student will then receive an email confirmation when funds have been sent.**
- The recipient shall submit a short essay within thirty (30) days of completion of the awarded activity to the Performing Arts League, Inc., summarizing how this scholarship award was used and how it supports your involvement in the performing art. Specifically: how did the PAL award assist in your training?
- Credit must be given to Performing Arts League, Inc. in any printed materials, publicity, including websites. When no printed information is used, verbal credit shall be given prior to each performance or presentation.
