

GUIDELINES FOR SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION 2024 (Revised Jan. 4, 2024)

Thank you for your dedication to the performing arts and your interest in the Performing Arts League Scholarship program. The purpose of the Performing Arts League Scholarship program is to encourage individual development and training of student artists in the performance disciplines of Dance, Theater, Instrumental and Vocal Music.

Scholarships are available to students who are current 8th - 11th graders who are active participants in Hamilton County 501(c)3 performing arts organizations. More than one student within the organization may make one scholarship request each. Only one scholarship awarded will be allocated per student per year.

Scholarship applications will be evaluated on the following criteria:

- Evidence that the requested scholarship meets the purpose of the PAL scholarship program as stated above.
- Evidence that the scholarship will aid the student's artistic goals, increase his/her abilities & selected program is compatible with PAL's mission.
- Evidence that teacher recommendation supports student's application & chosen program.
- Evidence that the student has thoughtfully completed application and included all requested information.

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Read all instructions and questions thoroughly. Contact PAL with any questions.

To complete, copy and paste Application pages 2 – 3 ONLY into a Word document then complete document. Type all information. Be sure to answer all questions and complete all requested information.

Save your document as a pdf and submit completed pdf application document to PAL at specified email. Only submit pages 2-3. No paper applications will be accepted. You should receive an email confirmation of receipt by PAL within 48 hours of submission.

Complete Scholarship Application submission must emailed by midnight MARCH 11.

In the interest of fairness and equity, late applications will not be considered. We suggest you request email read receipt upon submission.

Only complete applications will be considered, all sections and requested information must be included.

Students: it is your responsibility to confirm that your teacher recommendation has been sent to PAL. Notification of awards will be made by April 30, 2024.

- The scholarship award must be used only for the requested need. The award will be paid directly to the performing arts organization, camp, workshop that you will attend, or named teacher with whom you will study.
- The recipient shall submit a short essay within thirty (30) days of completion of the awarded activity to the Performing Arts League, Inc., summarizing how this scholarship award was used and how it supports your involvement in the performing art.
- Credit must be given to Performing Arts League, Inc. in any printed materials, publicity, including websites. When no printed information is used, verbal credit shall be given prior to each performance or presentation.
